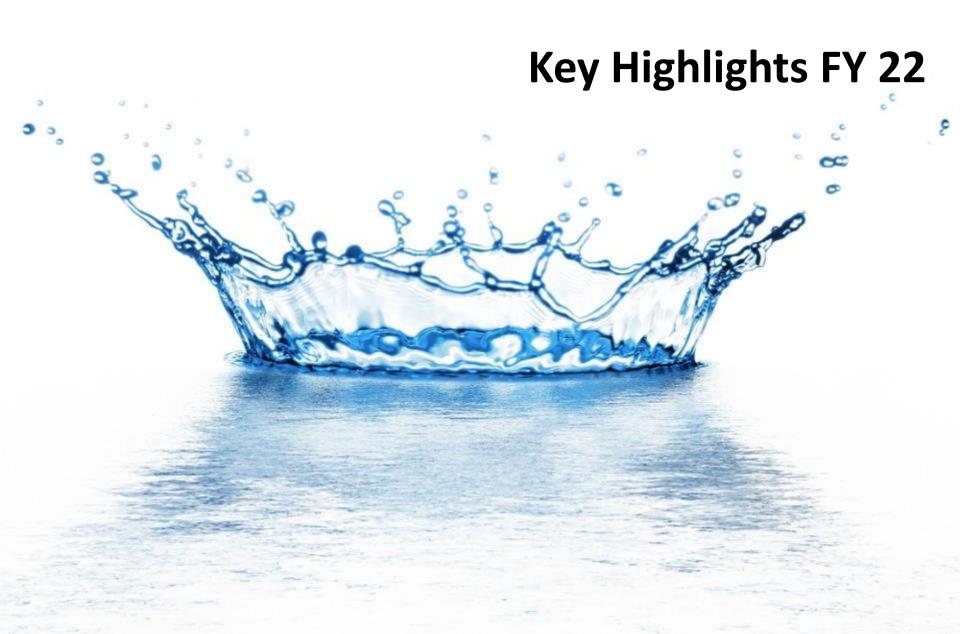

- Net Working Capital improves to 87 days; 10% reduction YoY; Current Trade Receivables remains flat despite higher sales YoY

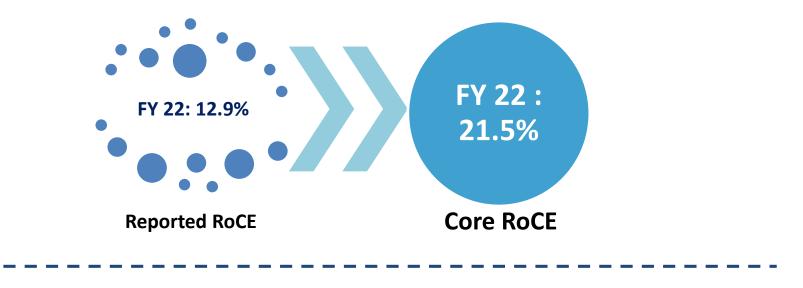

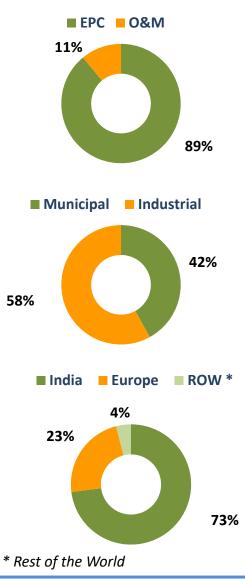
